

## McKenzie Institute Canada- Course Eligibility Policy 2018

All health professionals are responsible for adhering to their scope of practice. Adherence to your scope of practice is also required when participating in a McKenzie Institute course. For some clinicians, some course content may fall outside of their scope of practice. In that event, the clinician should not participate in those areas of the course. Therefore, a TRP may not realize the full value of the more advanced courses. A letter from the supervising clinician is required prior to the payment processing deadline or access to the live course may be declined and cancellation penalties will be incurred.

A letter from the supervising clinician must be submitted prior to the payment processing date or access to the live course will be declined and cancellation penalties will be incurred.
Physiotherapy Assistant	PTA	√	√					PTA's must have completed a <u>4 term or longer</u> certification program and must be <u>working under the direct supervision of a McKenzie trained clinician</u> (PT, DC, DO, MD, PA, OT, NP) with the same or higher level of MDT training. Letter from supervising clinician to be submitted prior to the payment processing date or cancellation penalties may be incurred.
