MICanada Phil Burchell MDT Diploma Scholarship Travel Bursary Criteria

- The bursary will be awarded to one successful Phil Burchell Diploma Candidate annually
- Maximum allowance provided is \$3000.00 CAD
- Amount allocated will be determined by distance to the clinical site (minimum distance required to be eligible is 200 klms from origin city to Montreal based on Google distance calculator)
- The successful candidate must submit a projected expected expense report to MICanada once the clinical date is set by MII and firm travel plans can be made.
- The bursary amount will be refunded upon submission of valid receipts and proof of attendance at clinical component
- Reimbursement will be made by MICanada directly to the Diploma Candidate via e-transfer within 15 days of submission of receipts and final report.

Accepted Expenses:

Regardless of the total amount of the expenses submitted, the travel bursary will only reimburse up to \$3000.00 CAD.

Travel: 30 day or more, advance purchase, restricted economy air or train fares, or a driving allowance for one-way distances greater than 200klms and less than 500 klms, maximum total mileage paid out roundtrip is 1000 klms at a rate of .50 cents per klm, based on Google distance calculator.

Accommodation: Receipts accepted by recognized business providing official receipts. Accommodation receipts must show a breakdown of nightly room charges and taxes. Meals and incidentals must be separated out of accommodation receipts.

Meals: The successful candidate can claim up to \$150.00 per week meal allowance without receipts, to a maximum of \$1350.00 for a total of 9 weeks.

Local transportation or parking: The successful candidate can claim up to \$300.00 with receipts from a recognized business.
